From the Head of Junior School

Dear Parents

I had an amusing conversation with one of our youngest students last week. When talking to several boys in the playground about their holidays one of the boys, who shall remain nameless, said, 'I know what you do in your office Mr Campbell.' Obviously this young child had undertaken some serious research about the role of a primary school principal, as he attended another school last year. The conversation continued, 'Mr Campbell, when we are reading after lunch you go back to your office and have a sleep.' This made me laugh!

While I tend not to comment much on what I do in my job, and I never wish to be a self-publicist, given one young boy's comment I thought I might outline some of the key items I was involved with last week.

On Monday I attended a Toowoomba Regional Council School Traffic Working Group meeting, as the independent schools' representative for the region. This involved examining the safety of children outside various schools in the region, including requests for crossing zones, speed limits and bus stops. On Monday evening I attended the Junior School Supporters' Group meeting, with the focus being on community building and fundraising. This Group, led by Mrs Rhonda Wilkie as President, supports the Junior School wonderfully well.

On Tuesday I attended the weekly Executive Meeting, which the Headmaster, Mr Hauser chairs. This meeting brings together the most senior staff members at our school (P - 12) and examines strategic issues and various other matters. On Wednesday we had our Junior School staff meeting after school. On the same evening, Mr Sharpe and I attended the annual IPSHA (Independent Primary School Heads of Australia) Leaders' Dinner, with our Year 6 student leaders, which is always a special occasion for these boys.

On Thursday we had our Semester One Academic Awards Assembly, which is very much like a mid-year Speech Day. On the same evening I attended the Junior School Musicians' Cup, with more than 20 of our finest musicians competing at this adjudicated competition. The results are featured elsewhere in this newsletter.

Each Friday morning we have our Junior School leadership meeting, where Mr Sharpe, Mr Anderson, Mrs Heffernan and I meet to examine all matters relating to the Junior School. On Friday afternoon I coached our Under 8 rugby team and then ran around with these boys on Saturday at Dalby (coaches run on the field with their team in the Under 6 to Under 8 divisions). I also enjoyed watching our Under 7 team play. During a normal working week I also have numerous meetings with staff, boys and parents, enrolment interviews and I always undertake a number of playground duties. I think this commentary also highlights a range of activities that occur in our School across a normal week.

Cross Country State Championships

The State Championships for Cross Country were held at the start of the term. Charlie Randall in Year 6 won the Under 11 event, officially becoming a State Champion. Archer Black, also in Year 6, finished in sixth place in the same race and both boys now progress to the National Championships later this year. Charlie and Archer also competed in the cross country relay event, with the Darling Downs' team finishing in second place. Judd Rei (Year 6) was announced as Captain of the Darling Downs' team and competed well in the Under 12 event. Congratulations to all three boys.

Makerspace

This week saw the official opening of the Junior School's Makerspace. The Makerspace is a technology centre, where all boys will engage with coding, robotics and various other aspects of the Technologies strands of the Australian Curriculum. This is a redevelopment of two rooms that were previously computer labs, adjoining the library. The dividing wall between the two rooms was removed along with all desktop computers and benches. The desktop computers have been replaced with laptops. New furniture, acoustic pin boarding, robotics and a large touch screen have been installed and capacity to video lessons has been introduced. The boys are excited by this development and the opportunities it provides. The associated photographs help paint a picture.
