Volume One: THE FIRST CENTURY

- The years 1877 to 1903 before the School published a magazine and details the 12 GPS matches played against BGS and IGS, the boys who played for the School and the match details that could be found in historical newspapers of that time - almost totally information previously unknown to the School;
- a chapter covering a total overview of the School's cricket history with detailed summaries of GPS matches and of the great individual players who became our champion batsmen, bowlers and all rounders and of the family dynasties of TGS cricket and of the greatest GPS matches played;
- the decades from 1901 through to 1979 are covered in separate chapters in a consistent format covering all aspects of TGS cricket life and the teams' performances as well as the individual better performers and a detailed description of every GPS and DC match played.

Volume Two: 1980-2020 NOT OUT

- The decades 1980 to 2020 inclusive;
- a chapter covering the selection of four teams considered to be the greatest players over 144 years;
- a chapter covering the GPS 1st XI players who went on to State (and International) representation;
- a pictorial chapter of all the GPS 1st XI teams that won the premiership in chronological order;
- a chapter setting out the names in alpha order of all the 1001 boys who played for the TGS 1st XI since 1877 (to 2020) plus their allocated player ID number (now embroidered on the caps of the 1st XI members).
